Excursion to Los Haitises National Park

The excursion begins with a scenic boat tour along the coast, stopping first at La Pesquera Cave before exploring the park's coastline. The second stop is at Shark Cave (Cueva dei Tiburones) and Bird Island (Isla de los Pájaros).

After about 30 minutes of cruising through stunning natural landscapes, the tour continues on foot to San Gabriel Cave, famous for its ancient petroglyphs, pictograms, and spectacular stalactite and stalagmitic formations.

The journey then proceeds by boat to La Línea Cave, known for its rich collection of Taíno pictograms, followed by La Arena Cave.

The excursion concludes with a boat ride back through the mangrove canal and a short walk to the Caño Hondo restaurant, nestled in nature, where a buffet lunch will be served.

Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel.

Whale watching in Samaná

Every year, between mid-January and mid-March, around 3,000 humpback whales gather in the warm waters of Samaná Bay to mate and give birth to their calves. Designated as a protected marine sanctuary since 1986, the bay offers one of the best locations in the world to witness this extraordinary natural spectacle.

The excursion is led by an expert guide who will share insights into the behavior of these fascinating cetaceans, making the experience even more engaging and memorable.

Santo Domingo – Colonial Zone Tour

A walking tour through Santo Domingo's historic Colonial Zone, following in the footsteps of the first settlers, accompanied by a private English-speaking guide.

The tour (approx. 3 hours) begins at Plaza de España with a visit to Alcázar de Colón, continues along Calle Las Damas with a stop at the Museo de las Casas Reales, and proceeds to the National Pantheon and the Ozama Fortress (Fortaleza Ozama).

The itinerary concludes at Parque Colón, home to the first cathedral in the Americas.

Passport, Visas and Health Formalities

To enter the Dominican Republic, travelers must hold a passport valid for at least 6 months. We recommend verifying any updates to entry requirements and health formalities before departure.

Health and mobility: the trip involves overland transfers, walking sections and activities in natural settings. Travelers are asked to notify us at the time of booking of any disability or reduced mobility, as well as any specific assistance requirements, so that the feasibility of the services can be verified.

Insurance: travelers are required to hold insurance coverage that includes personal assistance expenses during the trip, including repatriation or early return in the event of injury, illness or death. Coverage for expenses arising from the traveler's withdrawal from the contract is optional.
